



Product and safety information

1. Please read the safety instructions and assembly instructions carefully. We accept no liability for personal injury or property damage resulting from failure to comply.
2. Throughout the entire assembly process, take care to avoid injuries – especially when lifting heavy or long parts. Do not transport heavy and unwieldy furniture alone.
3. Make sure you are familiar with the necessary tools and use them correctly. Create a safe working environment.
4. The assembly and disassembly of the product, as well as opening or closing it (if possible), may only be carried out by adults.
5. All fasteners must be securely and firmly tightened during installation. Check that no fittings are loose.
6. If wall mounting or anti-tip device is provided, check the wall condition and install it properly.
7. If you are unsure, please consult a professional. Ensure that there are no electrical wires or utility pipes in the mounting area.
8. To avoid scratches, place the furniture parts on a soft surface. Ensure the piece of furniture is on a stable, level surface.
9. Tall and/or narrow pieces of furniture must be attached to the wall, otherwise they could tip over – even during assembly.
10. Please proceed carefully when inserting or removing shelves to avoid damage.
11. Do not use sharp-edged or pointed objects on the shelves. Hard impacts can cause damage or, in the case of glass shelves, even breakage.
12. The furniture may only be used as intended after it has been fully assembled. Make sure to align it correctly.
13. Warning: Choking hazard due to foil packaging and small parts! Keep away from children and never leave children unattended with the product.
14. Warning: Risk of injury if used improperly! This piece of furniture is not suitable for sitting on unintended surfaces or for climbing.
15. Do not use extended drawers as stepping stones.
16. Ensure even weight distribution: Heavy items should be stored in the lower compartments, lighter items higher up. Do not overload the furniture and observe the maximum load capacity.
17. Make sure that no fingers or body parts get caught, especially with children near doors or drawers.
18. Regularly check (at least every three months) that all connections and screws are tight. If the product is damaged or you have any doubts about its safe use, discontinue use.
19. Do not make any changes, additions, or modifications to the product.
20. Improper repairs or structural modifications (e.g., removing original parts or attaching unintended parts) can pose a safety risk.
21. Electrical components (if any) comply with applicable standards and regulations.
22. The permissible wattage of the light bulbs is indicated on the respective lamp socket. Exceeding this wattage can lead to overload and fire hazards.
23. Light bulbs must not be covered to prevent heat build-up and fire hazards. Refer to the enclosed installation instructions for the lighting and follow the operating instructions.
